CREW RESOURCE MANAGEMENT INSTRUCTOR (CRMI) 5 DAY

The CRMI core course is suitable for delegates wishing to attain CRMI accreditation or conduct Line Training. The course is suitable for instructors in ground, simulator and line training environments. The training is designed to develop knowledge and skills to enable the delegate to design and deliver focused and effective CRM training which addresses the nature of your company's operations, unique requirements and operating procedures. CREW RESOURCE MANAGEMENT INSTRUCTOR (LINE)

The CRMI (Line) course is suitable for delegates requiring CRMI (Line) accreditation for line and simulator training roles. This one day workshop for delegates with previous CRM knowledge and experience focuses on Non-Technical Skills assessment, NOTECHS and de-briefing skills.
